

TRIP SAFETY PROCEDURES

The following rules are designed for use on each trip, regardless if it is taken in church-owned, rented or private vehicles. The organizer and/or driver for the trip will ensure all participants read and understand the following “rules for the road”. All drivers must return a signed copy of Trip Safety Procedures to the church office.

- 1. Seatbelts must be worn at all times by all passengers and the driver.**
- 2. No hazardous, disruptive activity or noise will be permitted while the vehicle is moving. All passengers must follow the driver’s requests.**
- 3. Keep all objects inside the vehicle.**
- 4. All windows must be kept clear of objects that may disrupt the driver’s view.**
- 5. In case of an accident or emergency, stop and do not exit the vehicle unless instructed by the driver. Always exit on the street side of the vehicle, never on the traffic side.**
- 6. All drivers must adhere to posted speed limits. Weather and road conditions may dictate safe speeds below the posted limit.**
- 7. Violation of these rules may result in the termination of the trip for the entire group or the removal of a participant from the trip.**
- 8. My Safety and the safety of others is THE priority on this trip.**
